CPR/AED/FIRST AID/FIRE EXTINGUISHER TRAINING SEMINAR

A seminar will be presented by “On Scene Training, Inc.” with instructor Joe DiCorte leading his staff to teach the important life saving techniques with a hands on demonstration. Joe is a 25 year Fire and EMS veteran along with CPR instructor experience. Participating in the course will fill the requirements to receive Basic Life Support Certification issued by American Heart Assn. The cost for the course will be \$25 per person, paid at the time of the seminar.
